The deadline for submitting a regrade request is 5 business days from receipt of your official results email. Requests submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

Please allow a minimum of 10-15 business days for processing.

Eligibility:

Only exams with a preliminary score of 90% or higher are eligible for a regrade.

Each exam may only be regraded once.

(Note: Marked copies of the exam or specific content will not be provided. The review alone does not change your score.)

Exam Regrade:

Your exam will be reviewed by a different AAERT grader.

You will be notified by email when the regrade is complete.

In the unlikely event that your score changes, a new official results email will be sent and the regrade fee will be refunded.

(Note: While it is possible for a score to change after regrading, it is unlikely.)

Acknowledgments:

I have read and understood all of the requirements on this form.

I understand that a regrade request is a verification of scoring accuracy and not a re-evaluation of exam performance.

I acknowledge that regrades rarely result in a change to the final score, and that the regrade fee is non-refundable once the review process has begun.
